## REGULATIONS FOR THE HISPANIC FESTIVAL STANDS.

Please review the information below that summarizes the regulations that must be adhered to as a condition of participation in the HASA Parade & Festival.

- 1. Deadline for applications is <u>September 10, 2019</u>. Applications received after September 10, 2019 will be reviewed and accepted on a space available basis only.
- 2. Please remit your donation made payable to: H.A.S.A and License or Permit if applicable with your completed application. A confirmation will be sent after the acceptance of your participation.
- 3. We cannot guarantee locations and spaces from year to year. Even if you have participated in our previous events, you may be assigned to a different location.
- 4. A sign listing the foods sold and prices MUST be anchored to the stand and be easily visible to the customers.
- 5. Each stand must be set up no later than 12:00 pm and vehicles must be taken out the area of vendors.
- 6. Vehicles will not be allowed to enter for loading until 7:00pm
- 7. Food Vendors and tacos truck will be issued an earlier scheduled setup time.
- 8. POWER CAN BE ASSESSIBLE. However, we recommend you bring an electric cord not shorter than 100 feet. broken, chips, tear, or taped electrical cords will not be allowed (subject to inspection) this is a safety-code regulation.
- 9. A 10x10 TENT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED. The area is well exposed to the sun.
- 10. You are responsible for the clean-up around your stand and trash disposal. \$100 penalty will be charged for cleaning behind you.
- 11. All Vendors are responsible for collecting and reporting Virginia Sales Tax.
- 12. Failure to comply with any regulation may result in being asked to leave (or close your stand) and not being permitted to return to the festival.
- 13. 100% of the application fee must be mailed and paid by **September 10, 2019**.
